The Ski Resort



Aosta Valley - The Alps - Italy

We will be skiing the resort of Pila. It is ideal for all abilities of skiers from beginner to advanced. There are 5 blue runs, 17 red and 5 black. Blue runs are the easiest and black being the most challenging. By the end of the week, most groups will have attempted several red runs and some trying the black runs.







Accomodation







Interski have booked us in to the Hotel Dujany. This is a family run hotel with plenty of room for us all. Breakfast and dinner will be served here each day and students will share rooms. The room allocation will be done appropriately according to age and social groups.

The Daily Schedule

A typical day starts with breakfast at around 7am. We will then prepare for the day, board the coach and travel to the ski hire facility. After grabbing skis, boots and poles it's on to the lifts to the top of the mountain.

At 10:00am students will have their first two hours tuition. We will have a lunchbreak with pizza or pasta, before the final two hours of tuition continue. We end the day by heading back to the hotel for some downtime.







Evening Activities



8pm till late – evening activity schedule:

This is what we call Apres Ski. After dinner, the coach will take us to one of the evening activities that are planned. This could be bowling, film night, pizza night, ice cream night and many more. All students will enjoy the same evening activities.

Ski Lessons



Before departing we will all take lessons at Hemel Snow Centre. This will ensure we have a headstart when we reach the mountains, as many will never have tried ski boots on, or figured out how to attach skis.

We will have 3 x 1.5 hours lessons to make sure that the first day in the mountains is an enjoyable one.

Lessons are included in the total price of the trip.









The total of £1500 will cover:

- Coach hire, including two drivers
- Lift pass
- Equipment hire (ski, boots, poles, etc.)
- Evening activities
- Spending money

At the moment, £1500 is a guide. I am hoping for it to be less than this, however this is dependant on when we book. Ideally we will be paying the deposit to Interski at the start of February. You will need to pay a non refundable deposit of approx. £100 on School Gateway.
