WHAT CAN YOU DO TO IMPROVE YOUR LEARNING EXPERIENCE?

- BE ORGANISED: Come prepared to your lessons with the Home Learning/Pre-Reading completed and all the resources you need (textbook, folder, paper, pencil case).
- BE RESILIENT: A-Levels are challenging and require lots of practice and determination in order to succeed. Work with your teachers to target the skills/ knowledge you are struggling to grasp.
- **READ AROUND THE SUBJECT:** Ensure that you are outward facing, looking to current affairs, news stories, articles, journals, books and other mediums to extend your learning experience. Speak to your teacher(s) about this!
- MAXIMISE YOUR LEARNING TIME: Engage with lessons fully, do all that is asked
 of you and take the time to challenge yourself. As an A-Level student, you should
 be proactive when it comes to your learning, seeking out support and additional
 work when needed.

LEARNING BEYOND THE CLASSROOM: PREPARING YOURSELF FOR BLENDED LEARNING

When you undertake your courses the learning experience will develop. More emphasis is put on the student to come prepared for lessons.

HOW MIGHT THIS WORK?

- Students will embark on a transition programme which sees all students complete bridging tasks over the summer before their entry into Sixth Form.
- Students are encouraged to talk openly with their teachers and Mr Cook about their aspirations and future plans. This will inform the planning of our personal development and enrichment programmes.
- All students will engage in our careers programme including the use of Unifrog to help guide them towards their next steps.
- Students are encouraged to engage in online courses (MOOC's) and wider reading to support their future applications for employment, apprenticeships or higher education.
