Dear Parent or Carer

I know you will agree with me when I say that the vast majority of our students are excellent representatives of Adeyfield Academy.

However, I am sad to report that we have received several complaints from members of the public in recent weeks about the behaviour of a small minority of students on their way to, and from, school.

This has included:

- Litter being thrown in the streets or into the gardens of local residents
- Bicycles being ridden in an unsafe or inconsiderate manner (e.g. ridden quickly along pavements or through car parks / doing 'wheelies' in a dangerous manner)

We support young people's right to ride their bicycles and to visit local shops outside of school hours. However, we cannot condone any behaviour that brings the reputation of the school into disrepute. If any student is identified engaging in such behaviour whilst in school uniform, the school will issue sanctions as appropriate.

I am sure you will speak with your child(ren) and reinforce the importance of being good members of the community and positive ambassadors for our school and neighbourhood.
